

Improve your reading, language, and math skills, and prepare for the GED® test. Register for **Pre-GED®/ABE and Fast Track GED® classes** by attending a placement evaluation to take the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). TABE scores determine into which class you are placed. **Placement evaluation cost is \$5** and takes 3 ½ hours. First-come, first-served. Maximum of 55 participants per test. A **valid, current government-issued picture ID** for proof of age and identity is required. **Open to adults age 18 and older who are not enrolled in private or public high school.**

Testing begins on time. No exceptions.
